Everything was arranged prior to my arrival including, shipments, provisions, security, fuel, events and many other things. All clearance and departure paperwork was an extremely simple procedure and went without a hitch.

Cape Town itself is an amazing place to visit some of the most stunning scenery and wildlife I have ever seen. There are many things for crew and guests to do both on water and ashore.
